## BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

Eleanor White from Alternative Care/Meals on Wheels thanked the Town Board for the contribution in the past towards the cost of food to the Town of Alden residents. Every donation is appreciated. This is the 20<sup>th</sup> year for Alden Meals on Wheels and the 25<sup>th</sup> year for Alternative Care Services of Western New York, Inc. They are constantly striving to increase enrollment of the people who need food. During 2011 there was a total of 78 people served. They would like to move on and provide more services. People that were interviewed in 1987 showed that there is a need for social and recreational activities for seniors and a 24-hour supervised home. They received calls from the State and Federal Government four weeks ago regarding increasing the Alden Meals on

Wheels program, and opening a social center for seniors. The Board of Directors have given the go ahead and the application has been sent in. It is a year or year and a half project and would not interrupt the Alden Senior program. She asked if there was any room in the Town Hall for this project? Other locations will be checked out. She will keep the Town Board informed.

Paul Loehr questioned why the Executive Session was not listed on the agenda? Supervisor Milligan explained when the agenda was prepared they were not aware there was going to be an Executive Session.

Supervisor Milligan recognized Doug Hammerneck, U.S. Coast Guard and presented him with a proclamation regarding boating safety.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS**

Councilman Weber received a phone call regarding a swarm of bees in the Town Park by the playground equipment. He fenced the area off and corralled them and will go and pick them up this evening when it gets dark.

Town Clerk Ralph Witt received a letter today from Marilla Volunteer Exempt Firemen requesting the use of our bleachers for their annual tractor pull on June 30, 2012. He would like this on the Work Session.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED BY COUNCILWOMAN RIDDOCH WHO MOVED ITS ADOPTION, SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN WEBER TO WIT;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Alden has been made aware of traffic safety concerns of its residents with respect to North Road in the Town of Alden, between Crittenden Road and CountyLine Road, and

WHEREAS, North Road is a county road, owned and maintained by the County of Erie but under the traffic jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation, State of New York.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS THAT:

- The Town Board of the Town of Alden hereby formally requests that a speed, traffic and safety study be conducted for this roadway, a section which is more specifically described as North Road, beginning at Crittenden Road and ending at CountyLine Road;
- 2. These studies are requested due to high speed traffic on North Road and traffic accidents on this section of roadway including the intersection of North and Crittenden Roads in the Town of Alden;
- 3. The Town Clerk shall send the appropriate paperwork, including a TE9 form and resolutions to the proper agencies for action on this said resolution; and
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

The adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly put to a roll call vote at a regular meeting on May 7, 2012, and was unanimously adopted.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED BY SUPERVISOR MILLIGAN WHO MOVED ITS ADOPTION, SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN WEBER TO WIT;

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE FOR THE AUTHORITY TO CONVEY TO THE VILLAGE OF ALDEN AN EASEMENT THOUGH A PORTION OF THE ALDEN TOWN PARK FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WATER LINES

WHEREAS, the Alden Town Board is requesting the New York State Legislature for the authority to convey to the Village of Alden an Easement through a portion of the Alden Town Park for the Installation of water lines, as described in the attached Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, the portion of said Park that the easement will be over, does not contain any improvements and is near the border of the Town Park, and

WHEREAS, once the underground water lines are installed, the surface of the easement area will be restored and will continue to be used for park and recreational purposes, and WHEREAS, the New York State Senator Gallivan has introduced Senate Bill # 7027 and the New York State Assemblywomen Corwin has introduced Assembly Bill # 10006, and NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS THAT:

- 1. The Town Board requests that New York State Legislature adopt Senate Bill 7027 and Assembly Bill 10006 authorizing the installation of water lines in the Alden Town Park in the area described in the attached Exhibit "A";
- 2. The Town Supervisor or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Town Attorney as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this resolution;
- 3. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution and all supporting documentation to the New York State Senator Patrick M. Gallivan and New York State Assemblywomen Jane L. Corwin; and
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

The foregoing Resolution was duly put to a roll call vote at a regular meeting on May 7, 2012, and was unanimously adopted.
