Baschmann Services for a Felling brand trailer at \$20,638.00, with no trade in value;

Alden Trucks, Ltd. for a Winston brand trailer at \$19,750.00, with \$1,500.00 trade in value;

WHEREAS, The Town Board after full and careful review finds that it is in the public interest to authorize the purchase of a new 20 ton tag trailer. trading in the old trailer.
