WHEREAS, the Town Board has realized the need to replace the air conditioning system at the Alden Senior Center the cost of which is estimated to be less than \$35,000.00;

WHEREAS, the Procurement Policy & Procedure Guidelines ("Guidelines") of the Town of Alden and the General Municipal Law state that the Town must obtain written quotes from at least three (3) vendors;

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer prepared and RFP and three quotes received by the Town Engineer as follows:

the highest quote is from John W. Danforth at \$67,316.00;

the second highest quote is from Petschke Inc. at \$41,000.00; and

the lowest quote is from TriR Mechanical Services, Inc. at \$29,565.00;

WHEREAS, TriR Mechanical Services, Inc. is the lowest responsible quote; and

WHEREAS, The Town Board after full and careful review finds that it is in the public interest to authorize the replacement of the air conditioning system at the Alden Senior Center.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS, THAT:

1. The Town Board hereby approves the hiring of TriR Mechanical Services, Inc To replace the air conditioning system at the Alden Senior Center at a cost not to exceed \$29,565.00;

2. TriR Mechanical Services, Inc must pay NYS Prevailing wages to any nonowner employees and must comply with all labor law requirements and postings prior to starting any work and must provide proof of liability insurance to the Town prior to starting any work; and

3. That the Town Supervisor of the Town of Alden is authorized to sign any and all necessary documents to effectuate this purchase; and

4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
