

Dear Alden Residents

The Town of Alden provides a comprehensive solid waste program designed to encourage recycling and waste reduction, reduce litter in our neighborhoods and ensure that waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner.

We at WM look forward to helping your community be as clean - and green as possible.

Trash

Trash is collected weekly. See attached listing for service day.

All trash (trash bags, general trash), must be inside the Town provided cart with the lid firmly closed. Trash cart must be placed within 2 feet of the street/ curb line by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. No trash bags may be set next to the cart unless it is tagged with an Extra Capacity Sticker.

- Extra Capacity Stickers can be purchased at the Town Hall for \$5.00
- These stickers will accommodate one 30 gallon bag weighing up to 40 pounds of household refuse.
- Each bag with attached sticker must be placed next to your trash for collection.

Recycling

Recycling is collected every other week. See attached listing for service day.


All recycling must be placed loose in your cart for collection. Do not bag your recyclables. Please refer to the attached listing of items that are acceptable in this curbside collection program. You can also visit <https://www.wm.com/en/recycle-right> for more information and resources.

Proper Cart Placement.

Please place your cart at least 4 feet apart and 4 feet away from any obstacles (trees, cars, mailboxes, etc.) to allow the automatic arm to lift and empty the cart. Place the wheels of the cart towards the house, and within 2 feet of the curb.



All trash must be bagged and fit inside the cart with the lid firmly closed. Material outside of the cart will not be collected.



Have your carts at the curb the night before or **no later than 6 a.m.** on your collection day

Bulky and White Goods Collections

Bulk items will be collected on your regular trash day during the indicated collection week. Limited up to 10 items per collection.

Please see the attached collection schedule to identify which week your bulk items will be collected each quarter.

Bulky items are defined as large items such as furniture that is too large to fit in your trash cart.

White Goods are defined as household appliances such as stoves & washing machines.

Acceptable Bulk & White Goods Waste

- Carpeting must be rolled in lengths of 4 feet or less, taped securely, and no wider than 18 inches.
- Large items must be of size that can easily be handled by two people.
- Small furniture, bedding, mattresses, hot water tanks, washing machine and large appliances.
- Freezers must have doors removed and refrigerant (Freon) must be removed by a certified service and must have an official "Freon Removed" sticker placed on the item by the certified service technician.
- Any item, such as a weed trimmer, or small lawnmower, with an engine requiring oil and gas must have those liquids removed prior to collections.

Any item outside the cart will be collected as a bulk item. Including personal containers and/or trash cans.

Unacceptable Bulk & White Goods Waste

Bulk item collection does NOT include additional regular trash bags, air conditioners, and regulated material covered by the New York State Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act, such as televisions and computers.

Dead animals, explosive and flammable materials, compressed gas cylinders, aerosol cans, motor oils, regulated and non-regulated hazardous waste. Pathological, medical, infectious, construction, remodeling, and septic waste. Sludge, junk automobiles, recreational vehicles (ATVs). **TIRES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
