Dear Resident,

Please be advised that leaves/brush should not be placed in the road. Placing leaves in the road is a public safety hazard for pedestrians, bicycles and can disrupt the flow of traffic in and out of our residential areas. We understand this is a very widespread issue in our town and we are doing our best to educate the residents of the dangers of placing yard waste in the public roadways.

## Yard Waste Guidelines:

- 1) Leaves and brush must be kept off the Road.
- 2) Leaves and brush must be in separate piles.
- 3) No grass clippings, dirt, garbage, construction debris or manufactured wood will be picked up.
- 4) Brush should be placed parallel to the road and be no longer than 8' long.
- 5) There is a two truckload maximum per month for brush pickup. No lot clearing or contractor generated yard waste will be picked up. This is the responsibility of the contractor.
