

Recreational Trail Guide

The Town of Clarence is committed to developing an integrated trail system that meets the needs of the community. Currently, there are 4 trails; Westshore Line Trail, Peanut Line Trail, Spaulding Green Trail and Waterford Trail. Together, these trails total 13.5 miles.


Future expansion to the trail network will include the Northwoods Trail and future phases of the Spaulding Green Trail. When complete, these extensions will further connect the community in an overall effort to provide trail linkages between parks, schools and neighborhoods.

The existing trail system provides access to several local destinations that give a feel for the historic character and quality of open space in Clarence.

WATERFORD TRAIL

Total Length = 1.2 Miles

The Waterford Trail stems off of the Peanut Line at Clarence Center Road and runs south through the Waterford community and out to Roll Road. In future phases, it will feature an extension through Northwoods subdivision to Greiner Road.


History Along The Trails

Total Length = 6.1 miles


— Trail — Road ■■■ Bike Lane

SPAULDING GREEN TRAIL

Total Length = 0.9 Miles

The Spaulding Green Trail begins on Goodrich Road across the street from Clarence Town Hall and runs through the Spaulding Green subdivision. In future phases, it will feature an extension to Clarence Center Road, and potentially to Kraus Road.

The Peanut Line Trail begins at the western boundary of Clarence near Transit Road and continues east, eventually connecting with the Clarence-Akron-Newstead Trail in the Town of Newstead (an extension of the West Shore Trail). The trail runs along an abandoned rail right-of-way.
