

Greenprint Committee Meeting Notes

Date: 2/03/26

Duration: 9:30-10:45 (1.25 hours)

Summary of Meeting:

- Town Supervisor Patrick Casilio joined the meeting from 9:30-10:00. He detailed his interests in procuring proper signage for Greenprint properties and clarifying usage of said properties for the public. M. Powers suggested that the tax implications of the Town Board creating another bond for the Greenprint program would be low and P. Casillio agreed to have Director of Admin and Finance Kimberly Ignitowski look into it. The committee discussed the idea of wildlife corridor in the northern half of Clarence based on landowners offering to participate in the program in that area. The committee will devise a formal proposal for P. Casilio's review by our next meeting on 3/3/2026.
- The committee discussed potential issues with public usage of the Greenprint properties, including maintenance of simple trails, hunting and loitering. Clarification on intended land use for town owned Greenprint properties (vista vs. recreational use) warrants future discussion.
- The design and cost of future signage was also discussed. The committee has many in house and external resources (Eagle Scouts, Clarence Arts Society) through which future collaborations can be pursued.

New Action Items:

- M. Powers to take picture of current Greenprint property signage and share with committee members.
- K. Eimiller to design initial new signage.
- B. Lehan to create new Greenprint map with POI's within proposed corridor.
- Members to assist with corridor proposal as assigned and needed.
