

LOCAL LAW No. 6 - 1961

A local law to amend the Erie county charter in relation to financial procedures on the adoption of the budget.

Became a law October 20, 1961 with the approval of the County Executive, no petition protesting. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state October 27, 1961.

*Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. Section eighteen hundred two of article eighteen of the Erie county charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 2. Section 1802. Tentative budget and capital program by county executive. On or before the tenth day of November of each

year the county executive shall submit to the board of supervisors a tentative budget for the ensuing fiscal year, a capital program for the next six fiscal years, and an accompanying message.

§ 3. Section eighteen hundred three, subdivision A of article eighteen of the Erie county charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 4. A. The board of supervisors, after one or more public hearings thereon, may strike items of appropriation from the tentative budget or reduce items therein, excepting appropriations required by law or for debt service. The board, after one or more such hearings, may add items to or increase items in such budget, provided that such additions or increases are stated separately and distinctly. Decreases shall not require executive approval.

§ 5. This local law shall take effect immediately.
