Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 93

A local law in relation to the required use of protective safety helmets by persons

as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Findings.

The Erie County Legislature finds that persons that fail to wear a protective safety helmet while operating non-motorized bicycles within any area of the eleven (11) Erie County Parks present a threat to public health and safety.

Section 2. Prohibition.

It shall be the duty of every person operating a non-motorized bicycle within the boundaries of an Erie County Park to wear a protective safety helmet while operating that bicycle.

Section 3. Penalty.

A violation of this local law shall result in requesting the bicycle operator to cease riding the bike if he or she chooses to remain in the park or else leave the park completely. A refusal to comply with the reasonable requests shall be a violation subject to a fine or civil penalty of not more than \$25.00 and/or mandatory enrollment in a non-credited course in bicycle safety education.

Section 4. Enforcement.

For the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this section, any peace officer of the County of Erie or a city, town or village in which a county park is located shall be responsible for enforcement of the provisions herein.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately.




