WHEREAS, Countystat is a variation of the Citi-Stat program. Citi-Stat is a computer database system that allows City governments to regularly review every aspect of its government. The program serves as a transparent accountability and management tool through which the city can collect and thoroughly analyze data on an array of civic issues; and

WHEREAS, the CitiStat program was invented by the City of Baltimore which claims that the program has enabled the City to save \$350 Million in the 6-years since its initial implementation; and

WHEREAS, it is likely that a Countystat program would help the County identify savings and efficiencies not currently apparent that would allow County government to operate more efficiently; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Buffalo implemented a CityStat program in the City of Buffalo since June 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Erie County Legislature is interested in hearing a report from the City of Buffalo regarding the implementation of CitiStat.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, the Erie County Legislature calls upon the County Executive to report to the Government Affairs Committee on the progress made on this Matrix Initiative; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Erie County Legislature does hereby request that a representative from the City of Buffalo appear before the Government Affairs Committee and discuss the successes and shortcomings of the implementation of the Citi-Stat program within the City of Buffalo; and be it further
