COUNTY EXECUTIVE

WHEREAS, it is necessary to recruit at Step 3 for an Assistant County Attorney position in order to secure and retain a qualified and experienced attorney in the area of medical malpractice litigation; and

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature hereby authorizes the variable minimum for the position of Assistant County Attorney, Job Group 16, Step 3, effective upon the commencement of County service, and be it further,

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Division of Budget, Management and Finance, the Office of the Comptroller, the Department of Personnel and the Department of Law.

WHEREAS the County Clerk's Office has previously expended \$53,611 on the purchase of a new telephone system for the Downtown Branch of the Auto Bureau, and

WHEREAS following installation of the new system it was determined that the system did not provide appropriate service to the office, and

WHEREAS the Division of Information and Support Services subsequently placed a different phone system in the Downtown Auto Bureau, and

WHEREAS the difference between actual payments by the County Clerk's Office for the originally purchased phone system and the one finally installed is \$30,188,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$30,188 is hereby transferred from the Division of Information and Support Services (DAC 110927510820), to the County Clerk's Office (DAC 110916131933), and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be sent to the County Executive, the County Clerk, the County Comptroller, and the Director of Budget, Management and Finance.
