WHEREAS, after a public hearing, held on September 23, 2008 by Buffalo Place Inc., and upon adoption of Intro 21-1, October 23, 2008, the Erie County Legislature determined that the total amount to be raised by mall district service charges for 2009 for the downtown pedestrian/transit mall special district shall be the sum of 1,248,662; and
