WHEREAS, the Jewish Community Center of Greater Buffalo is a well-known and respected community-based organization which provides a variety of high quality programs that include early childhood education and childcare, after school programs, services for seniors, physical fitness facilities, as well as an urban meeting place for diverse members of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Jewish Community Center of Greater Buffalo intends to establish at its Holland Family Building a *Tree of Life Terrace and Playground* that will provide a universally-accessible play environment for children of all ages, abilities and backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, as a result of increased enrollments in the early childhood and after school programs, the current play space at the Center is no longer adequate and needs to be expanded and redesigned to include age-appropriate, universally-accessible play structures and in addition, the terrace would be renovated and revitalized to enhance the multi-generational use of the outdoor facilities for families and seniors; and

WHEREAS, studies have demonstrated that integrated play environments, such as the proposed *Tree of Life Terrance and Playground*, benefit children physically, socially and emotionally; and

WHEREAS, the Jewish Community Center of Greater Buffalo has requested County funds in the amount of \$25,000 for this project, and such funds would be used in combination with private sector and earned revenue resources,

WHEREAS, the County of Erie employs approximately 9,000 employees in various capacities, including through the General Fund, the Road Fund, Social Services Fund, Grant Fund, the Buffalo and Erie County Public Library System, and Erie County Medical Center Corporation, and

WHEREAS, for the fiscal health and well-being of the County government and in the interest of accountability for the taxpayers, it is essential that budgeted and funded but vacant positions in County government be monitored and either filled or eliminated to save money, and

WHEREAS, while detailed information concerning such budgeted vacancies is routinely produced and monitored by the County Administration, no information is regularly or routinely shared with the legislative branch, and

WHEREAS, the prime function of the legislative branch is to serve as a fiscal agent and a check and balance regarding county finances, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature is unable to fulfill that mandated role without accurate, up-to-date information concerning position vacancies, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has not been regularly or routinely availed of such vacancy information and has not been provided with position vacancy reports and information for many years, and

WHEREAS, published reports indicate that the County of Erie may be forced to lay-off county employees in 2004 due to serious fiscal constraints, and

WHEREAS, the County Comptroller has not conducted an audit or review of position vacancies since April 2002, and

WHEREAS, by way of example, for more than 15 years, the County Executive has been required to submit monthly budget monitoring reports to the Legislature as a means for Legislators to monitor the County's fiscal situation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature hereby reaffirms its mission as a fiscal agent for Erie County, and as a check and balance on the powers of the executive branch, and be it further

RESOLVED, that given the technological and financial advances made in county government through the implementation of ERP/SAP, the Erie County Legislature hereby calls on the County Executive, Commissioner of Personnel, and Budget Director to immediately start providing bi-weekly position vacancy and position inventory reports to the Legislature, and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Honorable Body calls on the County Comptroller to initiate an audit of vacant, unfilled positions in Erie County government, including ECMCC, and all funds, and to report the results to the Legislature expeditiously, and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the County Executive, Commissioner of Personnel, Budget Director, and County Comptroller.
