WHEREAS, The good news for the Town of Tonawanda, Erie County and Western New York that NRG Energy, Inc.'s CR Huntley Station has been conditionally selected by New York State as the advanced clean-coal power plant initiative designee is an encouraging milestone for the spirit of our community and continued economic growth of our area; as well as securing and adding good-paying jobs, added tax revenue to support local services, ensuring a healthier environment and reducing our dependence on imported energy; and

**WHEREAS,** The conditional selection of CR Huntley's planned 680-megawatt power plant rests upon the strategic alliance between the New York Power Authority and NRG Energy working together to reduce the cost of the project and resulting lower cost for power generated by the plant in order to secure a long-term contract with the power authority; and

**WHEREAS,** In order to secure the permanent selection of CR Huntley, the NYPA and NRG Energy have eighteen months to reduce the cost of the project and/or secure additional funding; and

**WHEREAS,** A natural source of funding is the utilization of part of the \$650 million in federal credits remaining from the 2006 Energy Policy Act which aims to advance clean-coal projects nationally, and/or granting federal tax-exempt financing for the project to further ensure its official selection and long-term viability.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

**RESOLVED**, That the Erie County Legislature does hereby go on record in saluting the tentative selection of NRG Energy's CR Huntley Station as the advanced clean-coal power plant initiative designee of New York State as a positive public policy decision both economically and environmentally; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, That this Legislature encourages NRG Energy and the New York Power Authority to continue their strategic alliance on behalf of the residents of WNY to ensure that the conditional selection of CR Huntley becomes permanent; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, That this legislative body respectfully submits that all stakeholders collaborate with the WNY delegation to Congress to encourage the federal government to issue much-needed federal tax credits through the utilization of part of the \$650 million in federal credits remaining from the 2006 Energy Policy Act, and/or granting federal tax-exempt financing for the project to further ensure its official selection and long-term viability; and be it further
