WHEREAS, the Village of Kenmore through an Inter-Municipal Agreement (IMA) has agreed to reimburse the County of Erie for the entire local (non-federal) cost share, including 100% of any overruns up to a maximum of \$225,000 in local funds; and

WHEREAS, in Comm. 7E-5 of April 23, 2015 and Comm. 10E-16 of May 28, 2015 this Honorable Body approved this project and participation in the Preliminary Engineering (Scoping & Design I-VI) and Right of Way Incidentals phases of the project; and

WHEREAS, the County of Erie would like to advance the Project's Supplemental Agreement No.1 with NYSDOT which includes the addition of the Construction and Construction Inspection phases of the Project, by making a commitment of 100% of the Non-Federal share of the costs; and

WHEREAS, the NYSDOT supplemental agreement is in the total amount of \$935,000 an increase of \$815,000 over the County's existing Project agreement with NYSDOT; and

WHEREAS, the \$815,000 increase includes a \$50,000 100% locally funded share the estimated local share for the increase in Project cost is in the amount of \$187,000 which is available from the SAP projects hereinafter noted; and

WHEREAS, the \$187,000 increase in local share results in a total local share for the project of \$227,000 which is \$2,000 more than the limit of \$225,000 agreed to in the IMA; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the project without amending the existing IMA to meet a letting schedule agreed to by NYSDOT; and

WHEREAS, the Village has provided a letter from the Mayor and a Village Board resolution agreeing to reimburse the County for the additional \$2,000 in local share.

2. INTRO. 3-3 (2017)

MILLS, LORIGO, RATH, DIXON, HARDWICK & MORTON

WHEREAS, the 2017 New York State Budget Bill proposed by Governor Cuomo calls for a \$152 billion spending plan during the coming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, part of that spending plan includes funding to be directed to local municipalities to help pay for a portion of the state directed mandates; and

WHEREAS, in the 2017 budget the Governor has included several provisions that could allow him to withhold funding for local programs; and

WHEREAS, many counties and local municipalities, including Erie County, set their budgets for the current fiscal year during the final quarter of the previous year and include estimates of state aid that they use in determining what services they are able to provide, to allow for mid-year changes in anticipated state aid without being able to cut the underlying programs is unacceptable; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a budget is to set expenses based on revenue and then operate within that amount, the proposal by the governor could make budgeting for the upcoming years more difficult; and

WHEREAS, if the State is worried about how they will pay local governments perhaps it is appropriate that we revisit our priorities and learn to live within our means.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that this honorable body hereby opposes the inclusion of language in the 2017 Budget Bill allowing the Governor to essentially make mid-year budget changes while still requiring local governments to cover the costs of mandates; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that this honorable body implores the New York State Legislature to join us in opposing this additional flexibility afforded to the Governor due to the tremendous burden it would impose on local governments; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be sent to the Hon. Andrew M. Cuomo, the Western New York Delegation to the New York State Senate and Assembly, and any other party deemed necessary and proper.

WHEREAS, pursuant to proceedings heretofore had and taken in accordance with the provisions of Article 5-A of the County Law and more particularly a report of the Erie County Sewer Agency approved by the Erie County Sewer District No. 8 Board of Managers on October 4, 2016, an extension of Sewer District No. 8 of the County of Erie, New York to include the Aurora Mills Patio Home Development has been proposed; and

WHEREAS, a map and plan have been duly prepared by the County Engineers (Erie County Department of Environment and Planning) relating to such extension of the Erie County Sewer District No. 8, which map and plan have been filed with the County Legislature pursuant to Section 254 of the County Law; and

WHEREAS, there will be no additional capital costs incurred by or on behalf of the Erie County Sewer District No. 8 with respect to the extension of the boundaries of such District, but future annual charges will be assessed against a benefited area which consists of the entire area of the District in accordance with the respective proportionate shares of equalized assessed value for each parcel in the District and in accordance with applicable flat charges and charges based on units, assessed value and footage, specified in the District's Benefit and User Charge formulas, as such formulas currently exist and as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 258 of the County Law, the consent of the State Comptroller is not required prior to the extension of said Erie County Sewer District No. 8 because such extension is not to be financed by the issuance of bonds, notes, certificates or other evidences of indebtedness of the County; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing to consider said extension of the Erie County Sewer District No. 8 in accordance with the provisions of Sections 254 and 274 of the County Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

WHEREAS, under the proposed Project Partnership Agreement, Erie County is responsible for providing all lands, easements, rights-of-way, relocations and disposal areas (LERRDs) required for the Project; and

WHEREAS, to provide the necessary lands, easements, rights of way, relocations and disposal areas (LERRDs) for the project it will be necessary to acquire by fee, permanent easement, temporary easement, license or agreement or other vehicle approved by the County Attorney's office real property and access to property to allow for construction and post construction monitoring of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the necessary LERRDs is expected to be de minimis in nature so the public interest will not be prejudiced by the construction of the Project; and
