WHEREAS, the Akron Jesson Field is seeking to expand their airport, which has been designated as a reliever airport for the Buffalo-Niagara International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Akron Jesson Field is seeking to expand their hangar space due to a regional shortage of available hangars; and

WHEREAS, they currently have a hangar waiting list of 20 aircraft that are currently located at other airfields and have a waiting list of 5 current tenants that wish to upgrade to individual hangers with concrete floors and electrically operated bi-fold metal doors; and

WHEREAS, as part of their efforts to construct the new hanger, the airport is submitting a \$1.7 million grant application to the NYS Department of Transportation, through the Aviation Capital Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the NYS Department of Transportation requires they provide a copy of a supporting resolution from the home County's Legislature as part of the application process; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Aviation Capital Grant Program provides for 90% of funds and the airport will pay the remaining 10%, with no Erie County funds being required or requested; and

WHEREAS, this vital funding source will allow our entire region to benefit from an increased availability of reliable hanger space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that this honorable body hereby supports the grant application for the Akron Jesson Field's new hanger under the NYS Department of Transportation Aviation Capital Grant Program and urges NYS to provide the needed funding to the airfield for the purpose of constructing a new hanger; and be it further
