as follows:

Section 1. By Local Law No. 4-2000, the County of Erie elected to provide the benefits of chapter eighty-six of the laws of two thousand to its eligible employees. Now, it has become necessary for the County of Erie to extend the original open period; only employees targeted during the original open period are eligible to participate.

§ 2 The commencement date of this phase of the retirement incentive program shall be the 5th day of November, two thousand.

§ 3 This extended open period during which eligible employees may retire and receive the additional retirement benefit shall be thirty-nine (39) days, to commence on and include the 5th day of November, two thousand, and to end on and include the 13th day of December, two thousand.

§ 4 In interpreting this local law, the calendar dates set forth above as the opening and closing days of this extended open period shall be deemed controlling in determining the length of such extended open period, it being the intent of the Legislature that the last date on which eligible employees shall work shall be no later than the 12th day of December, two thousand.

§ 5 The County of Erie will fund the retirement incentive program provided in chapter eighty-six of the laws of two thousand by paying the New York State and local employees' retirement system five annual payments, the amounts of which shall be determined by an actuary. The first such payment is due the 15th day of December, two thousand one.

§ 6 This local law shall take effect immediately.


