The meeting was called to order by Chair Lindsey Allen.

Item 1 – Approval of 2/24/26 meeting minutes

- Motion to approve the meeting minutes was made and seconded.

Item 2 – Review of resident concerns

- There were no concerns submitted for review.

Item 3 – Public comment period

- There were three community members present, who provided feedback during the working session of this meeting.

Item 4 – Subcommittee for addressing resident concerns

- The ECCSAB Resident Response Letters document was agreed upon, and Secretary will attach the final document with the minutes.

Item 5 – ECSO Superintendent Feedback

- A new academy class started recently, the current total is 35 incoming corrections officers. The facility breakdown is 10 to the Correctional Facility (7 males and 3 females) and 25 to the Holding Center (22 males and 3 females). There have approximately been 4 retirees between the facilities, so the incoming classes should be filling actual vacancies.
- The current population is 735. 319 are housed at the Holding Center, 416 at the Correctional Facility, and 24 are awaiting state transfers.

Item 7 – 2026 ECCSAB

- The mission statement was approved and will be included in the annual report and website.
- Annual Priorities and Goals (working session)
