The meeting was called to order by Chair Lindsey Allen.

Item 1 – Approval of 5/26/26 meeting minutes

- Motion to approve the meeting minutes was made and seconded.

Item 2 – Review of resident concerns

- There were no concerns submitted for review.

Item 3 – Public comment period

- There were a variety of community members present to provide personal accounts related to the Erie County Correctional Facilities and/or Erie County Sheriff's Office.

Item 4 – ECSO Superintendent Feedback

- The population within the Correctional Facilities has increased since in the past two months. The population number was at 702 on 5/1/26, and as of 6/30/26 it had increased to 777. 345 individuals are residing at the Holding Center and the rest are at the Correctional Facility. There are 40 individuals ready to be transported to state facilities, 12 of which will be completed in the next couple days.
- The total maximum capacity (if all cells were in working order) of both facilities combined is 1384; 638 at ECHC, and 746 at ECCF.
- Currently there are 132 out of order cells at the Holding Center and 1 at the Correctional Facility.
- The spike in population is likely attributed to the time of year; crimes and arrests have long shown increased trends during the summer months. ECSO has no say in who

they receive into the Correctional Facilities. It is required for ECSO to take anyone who is brought in by arresting agencies/police departments until otherwise noted by the courts.

- Superintendent Noeth stated that they are working to mitigate the heat within the facilities via fans and repairs to current temperature control systems.

Item 5 – Annual Report vote

- The 2025-2026 Annual Report was approved.

Item 6 – Presentation to the Legislature

- The presentation will occur on 7/9/26 at the Legislature. The Board Chair encouraged members to be in attendance.

Item 7 – Vote on updated Bylaws

- The noted edits to the Bylaws were approved.

Item 8 – Additional issues/topics to address

- There was a comment from a Board member and continued with community members of how incarcerated individuals and employees know they can submit complaints, feedback, and concerns directly to the Board.

Item 9 – Adjournment

- With all business addressed, the Co-Chair adjourned the meeting and confirmed that the next meeting will be held Tuesday, July 28th, 2026, at 5:00 PM in the Chambers of the Legislature.
