SUPERVISOR- Auditors Report is on file with the Town Clerk. GASB has changed the reporting standards for municipalities. The town received a glowing report for 2004. Councilman Decker questioned if there will be a new separate fund for the drainage district next year? The Supervisor answered yes. Councilman Decker also questioned Page 6 regarding the current assets to liabilities ratio. What was it in the past? The Supervisor will get those numbers to the Board. The Supervisor explained that under GASB, municipalities are now accountable more like a business would be. There are more dollars that are now separately accounted for, which better illustrate a town's financial position.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Water District #10/Water Tank-They are continuing work on Maple Road and spreading out to Carney Rd, Swift Mills Rd, and Scotland Rd. The proximity of hydrants to roadside has been questioned. It is largely due to the curve of the roads and the width of the right-of-way.

The concrete work and tank erection are on schedule for the Water Tank project.

Town Hall Project: Handicapped Accessible Entrance- Project almost complete with the heater on order and signage in progress. The Grant has been applied for.
