RESOLUTION ADOPTING
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

REFUNDING BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF NEWSTEAD,
NEW YORK, ADOPTED JUNE 14, 2021, AUTHORIZING THE
REFUNDING OF CERTAIN OUTSTANDING BONDS OF SAID
TOWN, STATING THE PLAN OF REFUNDING, APPROPRIATING
AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,250,000 FOR SUCH PURPOSE,
AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF REFUNDING BONDS IN THE
PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$1,250,000 TO
FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION, AND MAKING CERTAIN
OTHER DETERMINATIONS RELATIVE THERETO

The object or purpose is to refund all or a portion of certain outstanding bonds of the Town issued in 2013 for construction of a new highway facility.

The periods of probable usefulness of the objects or purposes for which the bonds to be refunded were issued is twenty-five (25) years.

The maximum amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$1,250,000.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF NEWSTEAD, NEW YORK, ADOPTED FEBRUARY 25, 2018 AND AMENDED JUNE 14, 2021, APPROPRIATING \$1,500,000 FOR THE INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT OF FACILITIES OF THE TOWN OF NEWSTEAD CONSOLIDATED WATER DISTRICT NO. 1, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000 TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF ANY GRANT FUNDS TO BE RECEIVED FOR SAID PURPOSE

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the increase and improvement of facilities of the Town of Newstead Consolidated Water District No. 1, at the estimated total cost of \$1,500,000, consisting of the installation of 3,600 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter PVC waterline and appurtenances along Knapp Road, 4,350 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter PVC waterline and appurtenances along Indian Falls Road and 1,150 lineal feet of 8-inch PVC waterline and appurtenances along Kirby Road, connection to the existing waterline, including acquisition of land or rights in land, if any, installation of new fire hydrants, equipment, furnishings, machinery or apparatus, and any ancillary or related work required in connection therewith.

The maximum amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$1,500,000. It is expected that grant funds will be received from the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation WHA Grant program and/or other sources.

The period of probable usefulness is forty (40) years.
