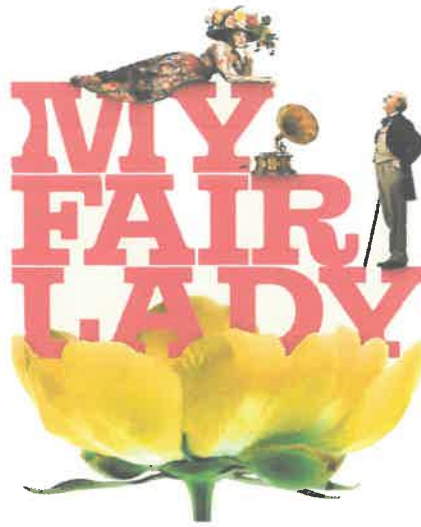

Your lunch will also include pie and beverage.

1:00 pm Depart from Betty's Restaurant and continue on to historic Niagara-on-the-Lake, Canada with its Victorian-era 19th century charm, scenic vineyards, and cultural allure. From award-winning wineries to tree-lined streets, this Ontario gem offers a perfect blend of natural beauty, colonial-style buildings, the Shaw Festival, Fort George, and wineries.

1:30 Arrive at the Shaw Festival Theatre (10 Queen's Parade, Niagara-on-the-Lake) and be seated. Doors open for seating about 1:30.

2:00 Enjoy a performance of "My Fair Lady", a timeless classic which has been dazzling audiences since its debut on Broadway in 1956.

5:00 At the end of the show, depart on your return trip home with a 7:00 pm estimated return time to the Akron Newstead Senior Center.
