#### **Summer 2024 Programs & Activities**

The Town of Newstead Recreation Department offers the following programs for Summer '24... AM Fitness & Fun, AM REC/PM REC, After Hours Swim, Field Trip Fridays & Special Events. Highlights for the six weeks of the NRD Summer Recreation Season include the following...
