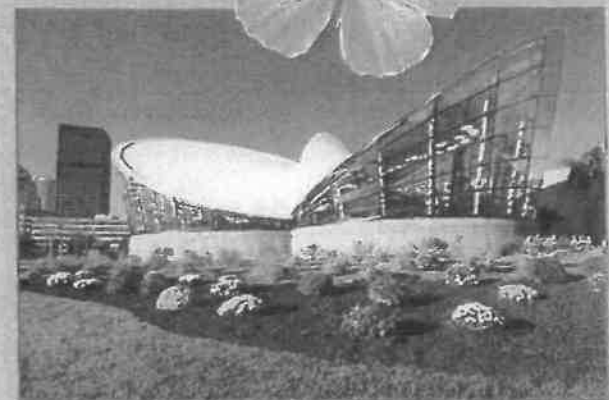
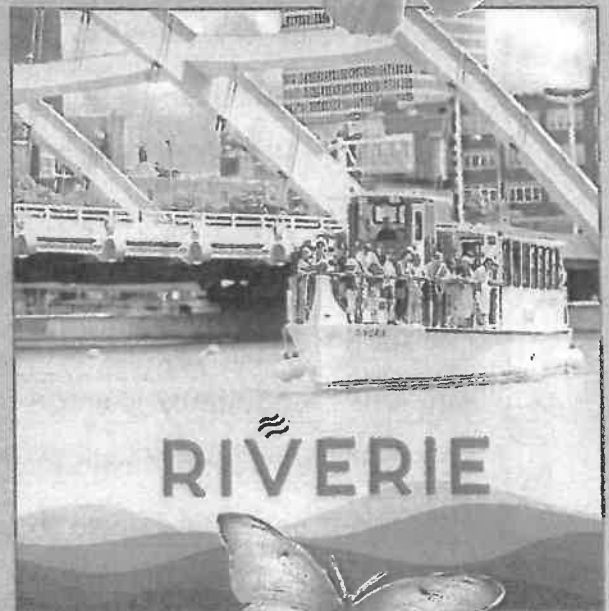

- 8:45 am Depart by chartered motorcoach from the Akron Newstead Senior Center (5691 Cummings Road, Akron) for Rochester.
- 10:00 Arrive at the Strong National Museum (One Manhattan Square, Rochester) for a self-guided visit in the Dancing Wings Butterfly Garden. Enter the lush rain forest environment including a turtle pond & a cascading waterfall. Walk among hundreds of brilliantly colored, free-flying tropical and native butterflies. See the brightly plumaged green Aracari Toucan & families of Button Quail.
- 11:00 Depart from the Butterfly Garden and transfer to lunch at Agatina's Restaurant.
- 11:30 Enjoy a lunch buffet at Agatina's (2967 Buffalo Road, Rochester) including roast beef au jus, chicken parmigiano, crab stuffed haddock, garden salad, vegetable medley, penne with tomato sauce, roasted potato, Italian bread & butter, coffee/tea, and dessert (a cannoli).
- 12:45 pm Depart from lunch & transfer to the Riverie Boat Dock at Corn Hill Landing (280 Exchange Blvd.).
