#### Day 1: Thursday, November 5, 2026 Overnight Flight

Experience a true taste of Irish splendor on a trip that combines four-star accommodations, stunning scenery, and tasty local cuisine. Make a return to times past when you embark on an unforgettable tour of the Emerald Isle.

**Day 2: Friday, November 6, 2026 Dublin, Ireland** Arrive today in Dublin, Ireland's historic capital city.
