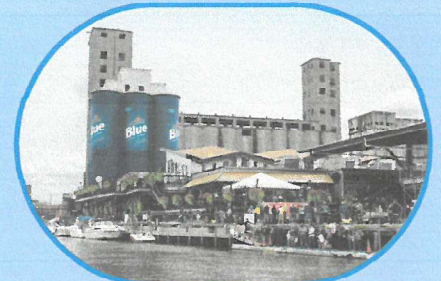
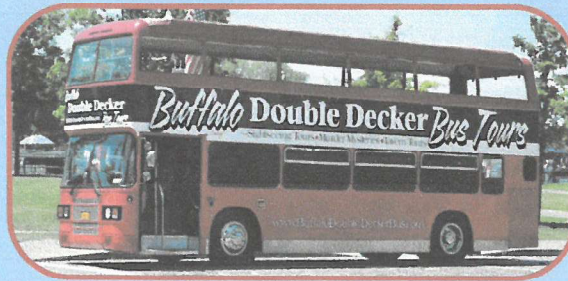
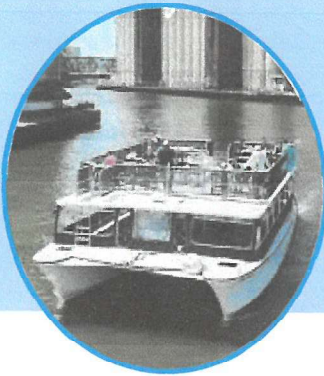


## BUFFALO BY BOAT & BUS with the Akron Newstead Seniors !

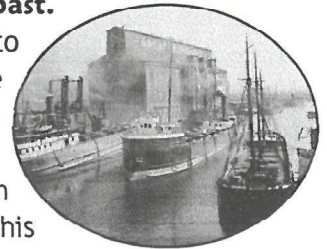

- 9:15 am Depart by chartered motorcoach from the Akron Newstead Senior Center, 5691 Cummings Road, Akron for Buffalo. *(Please park on the far side of the parking lot.)*
- 10:00 Arrive at the Buffalo River History Tour boat dock (44 Prime St., Buffalo) & board the Harbor Queen.
- 10:30-12:00 **Depart on a 90-minute narrated journey through Buffalo's storied past.** Travel the historic waterways of the Erie Canal & learn how Buffalo rose to prominence as the largest grain port in the world. Cruise alongside the nation's largest collection of standing grain elevators—towering relics of the city's industrial heyday—and hear fascinating tales of the "scoopers" who worked the docks & mills, fueling both the local economy and a nation in motion. From the days of the Erie Canal to the Gilded Age, discover how this bustling waterfront shaped one of America's great cities.
- 12:30-2:00 Enjoy **lunch at the Silos Banquet Room** (359 Ganson St.), which was newly built in 1923 and is located on the second floor of RiverWorks with a private entrance and elevator. **When you sign up, please indicate your entree:** Signature beer braised Pot Roast with Mashed Potatoes, beer battered Fish Fry & Pub Fries, or grilled Bruschetta Chicken on Mixed Greens. Your lunch also includes dinner rolls & butter, cake, and soft drinks/coffee.
- 2:15-3:45 Board your red **Buffalo Double Decker Tour Bus**, a restored authentic British double decker bus seating 65 persons (including 44 seats on top and 21 seats in the lower level). **Your 90 minute Buffalo Tour will be led by Officer O'Connor**, an Irish Cop who has been patrolling the city's waterfront since 1860. Expect Irish wit and a bit of blarney as Officer O'Connor tells the story of Buffalo's heritage and history. Hear about the former Psychiatric Center, the life styles of Buffalo's rich & famous, the gilded age architecture, Buffalo's most bohemian neighborhoods, the amazing architecture of downtown, and more. En route home, there will be an ice cream/treat stop *(individual expense)*.
