SBA Disaster Assistance Available for New York Businesses and Private Nonprofits

The U.S. Small Business Administration announced the availability of low-interest federal disaster loans for eligible small businesses and private nonprofit organizations impacted by frost and freeze occurring April 19 – 21.

Eligible Counties

New York: Albany, Allegany, Bronx, Broome, Cayuga, Chemung, Chenango, Columbia, Cortland, Delaware, Dutchess, Erie, Essex, Fulton, Genesee, Greene, Hamilton, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Monroe, Montgomery, Nassau, Niagara, Oneida, Onondaga, Ontario, Orange, Orleans, Oswego, Otsego, Putnam, Queens, Rensselaer, Rockland, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schuyler, Schoharie, Seneca, Steuben, Suffolk, Sullivan, Tompkins, Tioga, Ulster, Warren, Washington, Wayne, Westchester and Yates
Connecticut: Fairfield, Litchfield, Middlesex, New Haven, and New London

Massachusetts: Berkshire

New Jersey: Bergen, Passaic, and Sussex

Pennsylvania: Bradford, Pike, Potter, Susquehanna, Tioga, and Wayne

Rhode Island: Washington

Vermont: Addison, Bennington, and Rutland

Who Can Apply

- Small businesses
- Private nonprofits & faith-based organizations
- Small agricultural cooperatives
- Small aquaculture enterprises

Loan Assistance Available

- Economic Injury Disaster Loans: Working capital assistance for operational expenses caused by the disaster.

Key Loan Details

- Up to \$2 million in loan funding
- Interest rates as low as 4% for small businesses and 3.625% for private nonprofit organizations
- Loan terms of up to 30 years
- No interest or required payments during the first 12 months following disbursement
