The Sardinia Town Board held a Public Hearing on November 14, 2019 at the Town Hall/Community Center, for the purpose of hearing comments on the 2020 Preliminary Town Budget. Supervisor Gambino called the hearing to order at 6:30 PM with the Pledge to the Flag, led by Councilman Hochadel. The Pledge was followed by a moment of silence for Robert Schiener who recently passed away.

Supervisor Gambino then opened floor for comments. Lia Oprea spoke on behalf of the Sardinia Historical Society and asked the Board if they have considered adding funds to the budget for them for the upcoming Bi-Centennial activities. Supervisor Gambino noted that the Town already gives the Historical Society \$15,000.00 per year and the Bi-Centennial was a year away.

Supervisor Gambino asked three times if there were any more comments on the 2020 Budget. There were none. **Therefor the 2020 Budget Public Hearing was closed at 6:33 PM on a motion by Hochadel, seconded by Morrell and carried 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.**
