4-14-2022 - PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2022

Supervisor Gambino called the Public Hearing to order at 6:31 PM, with the Pledge to the Flag led by Tony Korcz. Supervisor Gambino stated that the reason for the Public Hearing was to hear comments regarding a Proposed Local Law to amend Local Law #1 of 2021 due to a clerical error. Town Clerk Bray explained that during the Codification processes a small clerical error was found in Local Law #1 of 2021. Town Clerk Bray noted that the words "Tier 2 Solar Energy Systems" had inadvertently been left out of section A, (2) (d) of Section 115-25 PR – Parks, Recreation and Conservation District: purpose. The Town Clerk noted that this in no way changes the law or its intention it just adds the wording that was left out of the original law.

Supervisor Gambino asked if there were any questions comments or concerns. John Schiener asked if this should be in both spots in the code under principal uses and accessory uses. It was noted that the wording only needed to be added to the one section. Mr. Schiener stated that he still feels that this law allows no much land to be used for large scale solar projects and stated that 2500 acres is huge.

Supervisor Gambino then asked if there were any other comments, question or concerns. There were none. She then asked two more times if there were any comment, question or concerns. There were none. Therefor on a motion by Hochadel, seconded by Marsh, the Public Hearing was closed at 6:37 p.m., carried, 5 ayes, 0 noes.
