Supervisor Gambino opened the regular October Regular meeting to order at 6:52 PM immediately following the public hearing on the proposed update to the Comprehensive Plan.

Supervisor Gambino stated that there were one set of minutes from the September Regular Meeting to approve. On a motion by Krist, seconded by Dabolt the minutes were approved, as submitted. Carried, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.

Supervisor Gambino stated that the next item on the agenda was the approval of the payment of the bills. Warrant #10 of 2024, including vouchers #521 through #576, totaling \$54,684.40 of which \$34,524.91 was for the General Fund, \$19,191.64 was for the Highway Fund and \$967.85 was for the Street Lighting Fund. On a motion by Becker, seconded by Krist, the Warrant was approved for payment. Carried, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.

Departmental Reports were as follows:

Supervisor Gambino reported that two public hearings needed to be scheduled. One for the Community Development Block Grant / Rural Transit and the other for the 2025 Budget. She stated that they would be held on Thursday November 14th at 6:30 pm and noted that the Regular November Board meeting will be held immediately following. On a motion by Becker, seconded by Krist, the Public Hearings were set. Carried, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.

Councilman Becker reported that the Senior Thanksgiving dinner has been set for November at the Holland Willows and that the Christmas dinner has been set for December 7th at the Annex. **On a motion by Gambino, seconded by Krist, the Board approved the dinners. Carried, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.**

Councilman Dabolt had nothing to report.

Councilman Krist had nothing to report.

Superintendent Dabolt reported that the broom that was ordered has been received. Lastly he stated that Hand Rd. was expected to be opened by October 28th.

Town Attorney David DiMatteo explained that part of the process of passing the update to the Comprehensive Plan would be for the Town Board to declare itself under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA). He stated that the following resolution needed to be passed for the Board to act as lead agency. RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Sardinia, having received no objection from any involved or interested agency, declares itself as Lead Agent; and be it further

RESOLVED, acting as Lead Agency, the Town Board shall review the proposed law and consider potential adverse environmental impacts of the proposed updates to the Comprehensive Plan pursuant to SEQR by completing Parts 2 and 3 of an EAF.

DULY ADOPTED, this 10th day of October, 2024 by the following Roll Call vote: Becker, aye, Hochadel, absent, Krist, aye, Dabolt, aye, Gambino, aye. So resolved, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.

Mr. DiMatteo stated that the next step in the SEQRA process is to issue a Negative Declaration. Mr. DiMatteo read through the items on part 2 if the Environmental Assessment form to ensure that all items are marked no. Once that was complete Supervisor Gambino asked for a motion to issue the negative declaration. WHEREAS, in accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR) the Town of Sardinia received no comments in opposition to the Town's declaration to seek Lead Agency, therefore the Town Board of the Town of Sardinia declared itself Lead Agency for this project on October 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, upon assumption of Lead Agency, the Town Board reviewed the proposed law and has considered potential adverse environmental impacts of the proposed updates to the Comprehensive Plan pursuant to SEQR by completing Parts 2 and 3 of an EAF (annexed hereto as *Schedule A*).

WHEREAS, in accordance with the same, the Town Board of the Town of Sardinia finds no adverse long-term or short-term environmental impacts with regard to the update to the Comprehensive Plan, and authorizes the Town Supervisor for the Town of Sardinia may issue a Negative Declaration on behalf of the Town Board, as Lead Agent in accordance with SEQR.

NOW ON MOTION OF Councilman Krist which has been duly seconded by Councilman Dabolt, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Sardinia received no objection from any involved or interested agency and thereby declared itself as Lead Agent; and be it further

RESOLVED, that upon declaring Lead Agency status, the Town Board completed and reviewed Parts 1, 2, and 3 of EAF and found no adverse impacts; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Sardinia, finding no adverse impacts, hereby issues a Negative Declaration; and be it further

RESOVLED, that Notice of Negative Declaration will be published in the Environmental Notice Bulletin (ENB) in accordance with §617.12 of 6 NYCRR; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board intends to adopt the 2024 update to the Town's Comprehensive Plan.

DULY ADOPTED, this 10th day of October, 2024 by the following Roll Call vote: Becker, aye, Hochadel, absent, Krist, aye, Dabolt, aye, Gambino, aye. So resolved, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.

Lastly the Board had a brief discussion regarding the Comprehensive Plan and completing the noted changes that were discussed during the Public Hearing. The Board agreed to wait until the updates were made before voting to adopt the Comprehensive Plan. There being no other business to come before the Board. On a motion by Becker seconded by Dabolt, the October Regular meeting was adjourned at 7:09 pm. Carried, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.
