Supervisor Gambino called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. with the Pledge to the Flag led by Gerard Whittington. Supervisor Gambino stated that this Public Hearing was regarding the proposed Community Development Block Grant funding for projects and for the Rural Transit Van service. Supervisor Gambino stated that the Town would be applying for funding for a project this year and that it was to upgrade the Town's obsolete elevator. She noted that the cost for the project is \$126,100.00.

Supervisor Gambino asked if there were any questions, comments or concerns. John Schiener what the total amount of the CDBG grant would be. Supervisor Gambino stated that it is a matching funds grant so the amount would be \$63,050.00 from the grant. She also noted that the County would be coming to look at the elevator on November 20th as part of the application and approval process.

Supervisor Gambino asked for a second time if there were any question, comments or concerns. Councilman Hochadel stated that the Rural Transit Van was a good service. Supervisor Gambino asked for a third time if there were any question, comments or concerns. There were none.

Therefor on a motion by Krist, seconded by Hochadel, the public hearing for the proposed CDBG funding and Rural Transit Van service was closed at 6:33 pm. Carried, 4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent.
