Supervisor Gambino called the Regular April meeting to order at 6:32 PM with the Pledge to the Flag led by Gerard Whittington.

Supervisor Gambino stated that there was one set of minutes from the Regular meeting held on March 12th to be approved. **On a motion by Krist, seconded by Hochadel, the minutes were approved as submitted. Carried, 5 ayes, 0 noes, 0 absent.**

Warrant #4 of 2026, totaling \$55,894.49 of which \$40,030.87 was for the General Fund, \$14,129.91 was for the Highway Fund, \$759.32 was for the Fire Protection Fund and \$974.39 was for the Streetlighting Fund. On a motion by Becker, seconded by Kittleson, the Warrant was approved for payment. Carried, 5 ayes, 0 noes, 0 absent.

Department Reports

Deputy Malican from the Erie County Sheriff's Office Community Engagement Team updated the Board on Sheriff's activities in the Town.

Supervisor Gambino reported that she is working on grants for the salt shed and new playground equipment. She also updated the board on the status of the elevator project and noted that a smoke detection system is needed before the elevator can be put back into service.

Councilman Kittleson reported that the annual town wide garage sale will be held on July 10th, 11th and 12th.

Councilman Becker asked the dates for upcoming events such as big trash pickup to be held on April 21st, Hazardous Waste drop off to be held April 25th and the Legion Memorial Day parade that will be held at 8 am on Memorial Day.

Councilman Hochadel reminded the board that the concerts in the park start in June this year.

Councilman Krist thanks Highway Superintendent for all the work the highway department has done over the last few weeks due to high winds and bad weather.

Highway Superintendent Dabolt reported that the highway department has started spring clean up and hopes to get the parks in the next week or two if the weather allows. He noted that big trash will be on April 21st and brush chipping will be after that.

There being no other business to come before the Board Supervisor Gambino asked for a motion to adjourn the April meeting. **On a motion by Krist, seconded by Kittleson, the April meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm. Carried, 5 ayes, 0 noes, 0 absent.**
