week 1 ---> Parks

- 1. Maintains a system of nine county parks, four natural habitat areas and 3,500 acres of county forest land
- 2. Provides year-round recreation for county residents
- **3.** Operates two golf courses and two beaches
- 4. Hosts festivals and events for people of all ages
- **5.** Protects regionally important areas of scenic, environmental and cultural significance



week 2 ---> Health

- **6.** Provides free testing for sexually transmitted diseases
- 7. Tests for lead in old homes and provides services for children with lead poisoning
- **8.** Conducts health inspections of restaurants, swimming pools, summer camps, beaches and other recreational venues
- **9.** Monitors and controls insect-borne diseases through the vector control program
- 10. Provides free rabies clinics and sends specimens for rabies testing



Commission on the Status of Women

- 11. Collaborates with community organizations to maximize services for women and girls
- **12.** Publishes data on women and girls to target need for education, policy recommendations and services
- 13. Runs board of community stakeholders
- 14. Creating a Domestic Violence Tribute Garden in Isleview Park
- **15.** Sponsors an annual Pay Equity Event to raise awareness





Public Works

- **16.** Maintains over a thousand miles of roadways and hundreds of bridges and culverts
- 17. Executes major capital projects every year
- 18. Manages all county-owned buildings and grounds
- 19. Regulates all commercial weighing and measuring devices, including gas and fuel pumps and meters in the county
- 20. Maintains county-owned fleet of vehicles







Real Property Tax Services

- 21. Collects real property taxes for 269,773 parcels in Erie County
- 22. Maintains current real property tax maps and data
- 23. Conducts annual in-rem property sales
- 24. Monitors PILOT (payment in lieu of taxes) agreements through the local FCIDA
- 25. Works with municipalities across the county to keep tax assessments current





Senior Services

- **26.** Engages, provides programming and advocates for adults over 60 especially low income, minority and disabled elderly persons
- 27. Provides resources and programming for caregivers
- 28. Offers fitness classes and nutrition programs to keep seniors fit, active and healthy
- 29. Coordinates the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP)
- **30.** Provides transportation for seniors through the "Going Places" van service





Emergency Services

- 31. Supports and trains Erie County's 97 fire departments
- 32. Manages emergency operations during county-wide disasters
- 33. Maintains a county-wide radio system and dispatches all ambulance services in Erie County
- 34. Trains all ambulance crews, EMTs and parademics
- 35. Manages Local Emergency Planning Committee to coordinate services and personnel for future disasters






Environment & Planning

- 36. Manages county-wide agricultural plan
- 37. Maintains sewers and wastewater treatment
- 38. Curates the process of funding local arts and cultural groups
- 39. Coordinates regional planning and economic development with other local governments and agencies
- 40. Funds community planning and housing projects and provides funding for small business loans and start-ups






Medicaid Inspector General

- **41**. Roots out waste, fraud and abuse of \$1 billion in Medicaid funding in Erie County
- **42.** Actively investigates and audits Medicaid providers
- 43. Produces reports regarding Medicaid usage in Erie County
- 44. Maintains confidential tip line for reporting waste, fraud or abuse
- 45. Works closely with NYS Medicaid Inspector General's Office





- **46.** Provides probation services to all Erie County courts
- 47. Manages cases for nearly 10,000 adults and juveniles
- 48. Operates an Alternatives to Incarceration Program
- **49.** Coordinates with social workers to supervise incarcerated defendants on release
- **50.** Maintains a community service program for juveniles on probation


- **51.** Provides advocacy for people with any disability in order to ensure equal access to county services
- **52.** Collaborates with disability community organizations on awareness events, career fairs and job mentoring days
- 53. Publishes a Guide to Services of resources for people with disabilities
- 54. Provides guidance on Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility issues to residents and municipalities
- **55.** Helps local residents with applications to services





Social Services

- **56.** Investigates allegations of abuse and neglect of children and vulnerable adults
- 57. Supports and assists foster parents and places children in foster care
- **58.** Administers assistance programs, including HEAP, SNAP, child care assistance and Medicaid
- **59.** Assists domestic violence victims, homeless individuals, juvenile defenders and those struggling with substance abuse
- **60.** Coordinates funding for youth programming





- **61.** Administers and monitors affirmative action programs for county government
- **62.** Investigates harassment complaints
- **63.** Audits county contracts for participation of minority- and women-owned businesses
- **64.** Monitors county hiring procedures to ensure compliance with affirmative action laws
- **65.** Provides resources to minority- and women-owned businesses



week 14 ---> Library


- 66. Provides residents and visitors of Erie County with free reading and programming for the past 175 years
- 67. Maintains 37 locations county-wide
- 68. Runs an active website with a library catalog and research database
- **69.** Manages 3 million items (books, maps, audio, video and digital)
- 70. Coordinates bookmobile services to underserved communities





Mental Health

- 71. Directs a local, comprehensive mental disability planning system
- 72. Maximizes state, federal and voluntary support for programs
- 73. Develops effective systems that assess and monitor the quality and effectiveness of care the mental disability programs deliver
- 74. Monitors the quality of care in contractual agency programs
- 75. Assures coordination of mental health, mental retardation/ developmental disabilities and alcohol and substance abuse services



Office of Public Advocacy

- **76.** Provides advocacy services to residents of Erie County
- 77. Runs Commission on the Status of Women to promote gender equity
- 78. Organizes events with community partners to promote collaboration
- 79. Offers education, analysis of legislation and policy recommendations
- 80. Coordinates annual United Way campaign





Veterans Services

- **81.** Ensures that every veteran in the county is registered in the VA System and is fully aware of all the benefits that they have earned
- **82.** Works to make veterans an economic force in education, employment and business development
- 83. Develops programs with local colleges and universities
- **84.** Partners with the Dept. of Mental Health on a "peer to peer" mentoring program for returning veterans
- **85.** Processes the burials of indigent veterans and next-of-kin of veterans





Erie County Sheriffs

- **86.** Provides road patrols 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and regular aviation and marine patrols
- 87. Investigates all crimes reported to the Sheriff's Office
- **88.** Executes warrants from Department of Social Services cases
- 89. Provides bomb removal and SWAT support to local law enforcement
- **90.** Investigates fires happening within Sheriff's patrol districts





Erie County Clerk

- 91. Records and keeps legal and official documents and records
- 92. Issues permits and licenses for automobiles, firearms, hunting and fishing
- 93. Ensures all court records are appropriately filed and maintained.
- 94. Administers laws related to motor vehicle sales, vehicle registration and driver licensing
- 95. Maintains six auto bureaus and one mobile unit





Erie County Legislature

- **96.** Provides legislative oversight for Erie County government
- **97.** Holds legislative sessions and committee meetings
- 98. Adopts and debates the annual Erie County budget
- **99.** Passes local laws, arts, ordinances and resolutions
- 100. Exercises oversight over the daily operations of county government
- **101.** Liaises with constituents to help them navigate county services
