

# **Fuel-Fired Appliance Requirement Checklist**



*The following information is intended to assist the property owner in having a fuel-fired appliance installed in a safe and ordinance-compliant manner.*

**A Building Permit is required. The following items must be submitted with the Building Permit Application:**

- Proof of compliance with New York State Worker's Compensation and Disability Law.
- A copy of the section(s) of the manufacturer's installation instructions, for the specific unit proposed for installation, detailing elements required for code compliance.

**The fuel-fired appliance installation is very important to minimize fire and exhaust gas hazards.**

- The fuel-fired appliance must be installed in compliance with the manufacturer's installation instructions and all applicable codes and ordinances. These may include (but not limited to) the NYS Residential Code, NYS Building Code, NYS Fire Code, NYS Mechanical Code, NYS Fuel Gas Code, and NYS Plumbing Code.
- Any modifications to the existing structure to accommodate the fuel-fired appliance must meet applicable code requirements and NYS Education Law requirements, as applicable.

**Inspections are required as indicated on the issued Building Permit**  
**A successful final inspection MUST be obtained prior to the use of the fuel-fired appliance.**
