Approved minutes of the Planning Board meeting on August 20, 2025

### **Preliminary Site Plan Modification Submission**

Change to western most property – prior approval was for self and large storage units.

Now proposing town house apartments (50 units, consisting of 11 4-unit and one 6-unit buildings). Removal of walking trail- now have an exercise room in the clubhouse.

Revisions to street trees and landscaping. Also moving pickleball court and dog park.

Parking is insufficient, near clubhouse. Board reviewed the CEO's list of concerns-

- and to recommend approval of the proposed modifications to the planting/landscaping plan for the Slade Drive project regarding the street trees and traffic circle, as recommended by the Village of Alden Planning Board.
