**April 28, 2026, 2026/2027 Budget Adopted. Tax rate for June 1<sup>st</sup> tax bills is \$7.678247. Tax levy increase 3.5497%. Effective June 1, 2026, Garbage charges increased to \$345 per unit. Water rates increased to \$7.95 and Sewer rates increased to \$11.75**

**May 1<sup>st</sup>** – Quarterly water/sewer bills (blue postcard) are mailed out to the resident or owner on record. Water/sewer bills are mailed quarterly – May 1<sup>st</sup>, Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, Nov 1<sup>st</sup> and Feb 1<sup>st</sup> and are due by the 28<sup>th</sup> of the month for each quarterly. Penalties of 10% are added on the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month.

**Middle to end of May** – Hometown Hero banners will be hung for the period of Memorial Day to Veteran's Day. It is too late to purchase a new banner for this year. If you have not paid the \$25 renewal fee for existing banners, please contact the Clerk/Treasurer's Office at 716-937-9269 x110 or x111 immediately.

**June 1<sup>st</sup>** – Village Tax bills are mailed to the owner on record of the property in the Village of Alden. If you have not received your tax bill by June 8<sup>th</sup>, please contact the Clerk/Treasurer's office at 716-937-9216 extensions 110 or 111. Office hours are 8 am – 4:30pm M-F.

**July 1<sup>st</sup>** – last day to pay your village tax bill. Penalties are added on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please make sure your tax bill is postmarked by USPS by July 1<sup>st</sup>. Full tax bill payment, no partial payments allowed.

**November 2<sup>nd</sup>** – last day to pay the village taxes.

**November 3<sup>rd</sup>** - village taxes are relieved onto the Town/County bill. Village can no longer accept payment for taxes.

#### **Bulk Trash Collection 2026**

Bulk household trash is picked up four times per year, with a limit of ten (10) items per household per pick-up. **NO Bulk Trash should be put out to the curb at any other time or for regular trash collection.**

#### **REMAINING BULK TRASH COLLECTION DATES FOR 2026**

**Mondays, April 27<sup>th</sup>, July 20<sup>th</sup>, and October 26<sup>th</sup>**

**We Cannot Take:** refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc. unless they have been tagged by an authorized agency or service technician that have removed the refrigerant in compliance with environmental laws.

- No Electronics
- No tires, toxic waste, yard wastes, or construction materials
- No 1-gallon or 5-gallon cans or pails will be taken unless the tops are removed, and the contents are in a non-liquid state
- KEEP empty propane cylinders on a separate pile from the rest of the bulk trash.

#### **CHIPPABLE BRUSH PICK-UP DATES**

All brush that can be chipped will be picked up on the first Monday of each month on the following dates:

**Mondays, April 6<sup>th</sup>, May 4<sup>th</sup>, June 1<sup>st</sup>, July 6<sup>th</sup>, August 3<sup>rd</sup>,  
September 7<sup>th</sup>, October 5<sup>th</sup>, and November 2<sup>nd</sup>, December 7<sup>th</sup>**

## **Yard Waste and Leaves**

Yard Waste (grass clippings, lawn rakings small garden plants, etc.) will be picked up on Mondays until the fall leaf collection starts. Once the fall leaf collection season begins, we will be picking up leaves as soon as possible, as we will be working a continuous rotation throughout the Village. Leaves should be raked into a pile or in a row at the curbside and **not in the street**.

## **Waste Oil**

Village residents may dispose of used motor oil between the hours of 9 AM – 1 PM Monday – Friday at the Public Works garage on Railroad Street. Please contact the DPW at (716) 937-7392 to schedule a drop-off at 13395 Railroad St. Do not leave items outside the buildings.

## **Electronics**

Village of Alden residents may drop off at the Public Works garage; 13395 Railroad Street, the following electronic items: Computers, monitors, printers, and other computer components, fax machines, televisions, cable receivers, DVRs, V+DVD, & VCR players.
